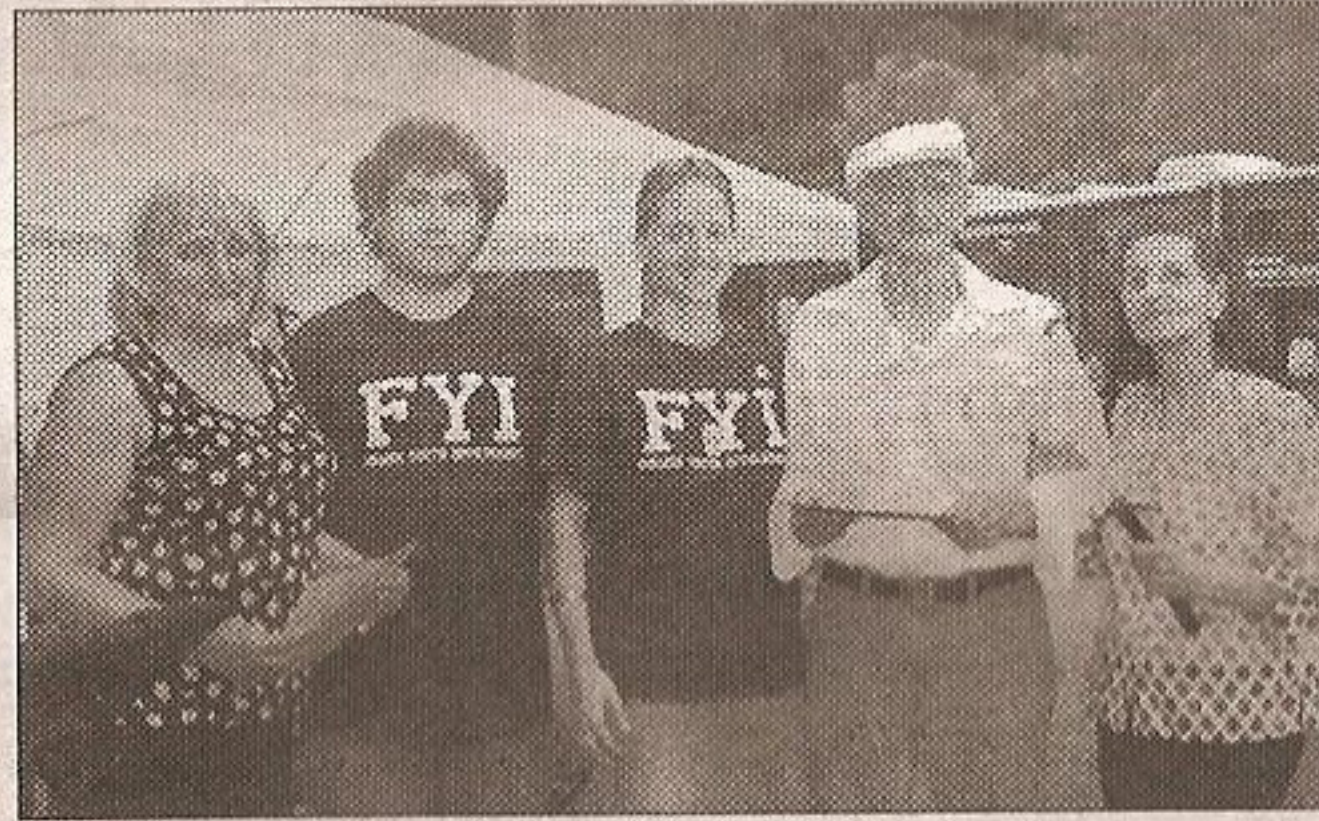


Missisquoi North Volunteer Centre honours volunteers

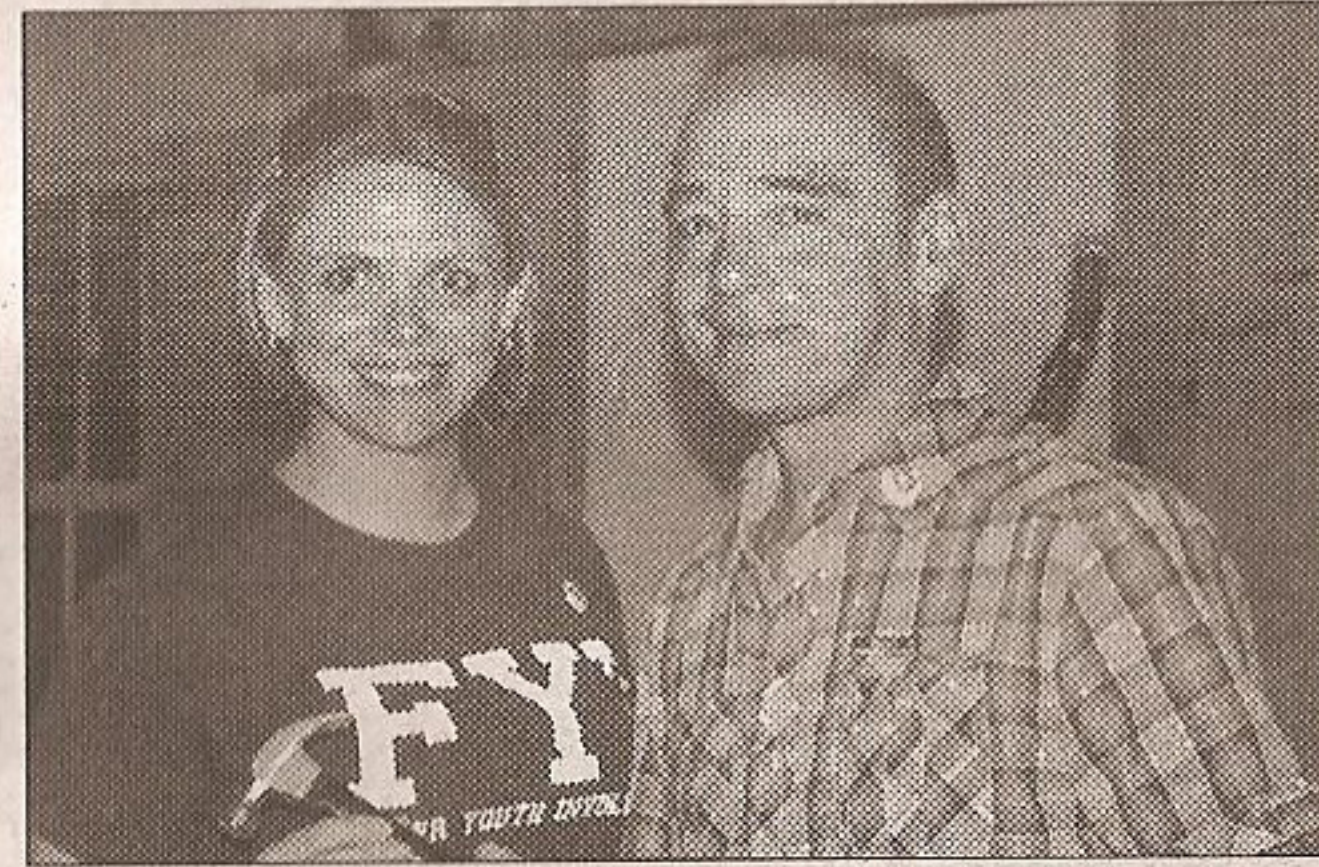
