ith two busy weekends behind them and Mother Nature fully cooperating the 2022 Owl's Head in Colours weekends are gearing up for a final three days on Oct. 8,9 and 10 at Owl's Head Ski Mountain in Potton.

Access to the site and parking is free. To access the chairlift, you must purchase a ticket and book a time slot. Unlimited season ticket holders for last season or the upcoming season will be entitled to one round trip, without having to reserve a time slot.

There are two types of tickets available. A round trip ticket allows you to reach the summit and descend to the base in the comfort of the summit chairlift. This is ideal for families with very young children or people with reduced mobility. A round trip ticket means you receive a wristband at the chairlift to grant you access to the descent. It is recommended to do an online purchase to avoid waiting in line and it is important to respect the time slot you book and to plan your day to accommodate your booking. There



is also the one way ticket purchase available. This ticket will allow you to access the summit by chairlift and then to hike back down the mountain via the Lily's Leap trail. This allows you to enjoy the spectacular view of Lake Memphrémagog.

Time slots are as follows...oneway ticket (ascent only) no time slot required. Last chairlift is at 3:30pm. Round trip ascent and descent 10 a.m. to noon, noon to 2 p.m. and 2-4 p.m.

Adult one way \$13, Round trip \$19 Family one way \$3, Roundtrip \$47 Youth (6-17 yrs) one way \$9,


Roundtrip \$15 Child (0-5 yrs) Free
