# annual “Sundays in the park” return in Potton

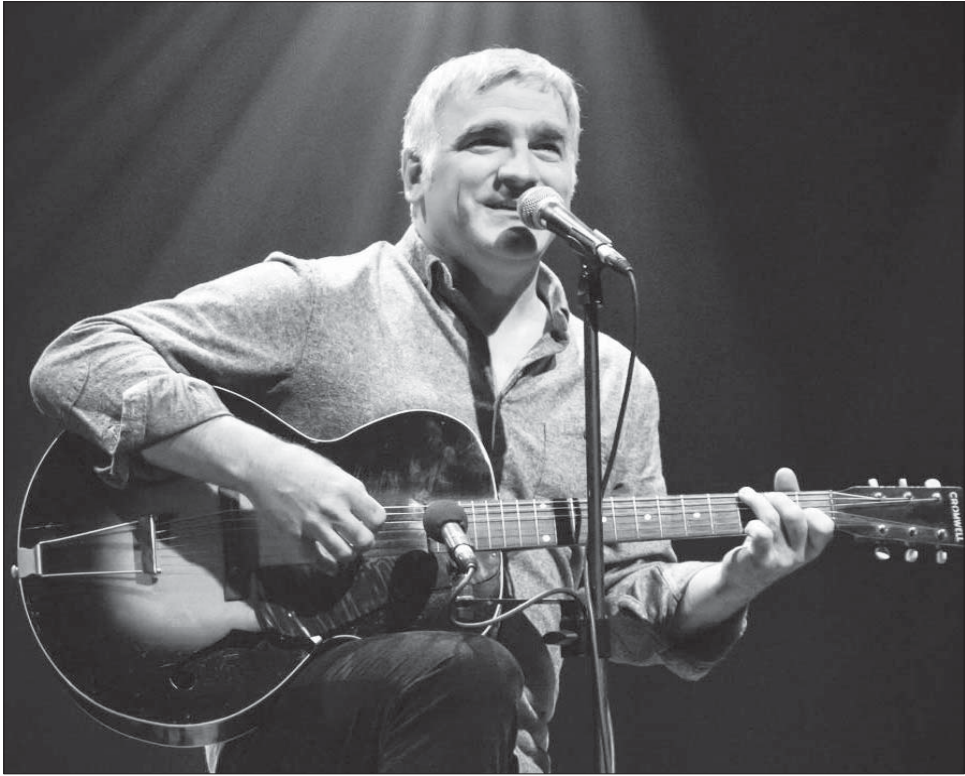


## THE SCOOP MABLE HASTINGS

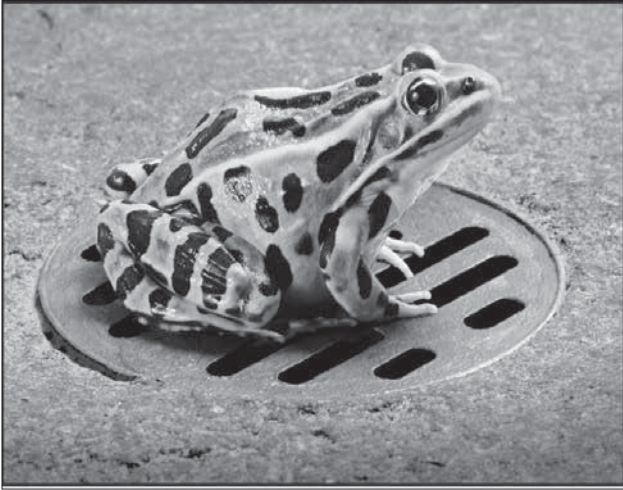
