

Commission recommends extensive governance and workplace reforms for Sherbrooke

The Commission Municipale du Québec (CMQ) has issued a report June 11 on the City of Sherbrooke, identifying significant issues in governance and workplace environment and recommending comprehensive reforms.

The recommendation follows two councillors recently resigning from significant public service roles, who cited pressure and threats as their reasons for stepping down.

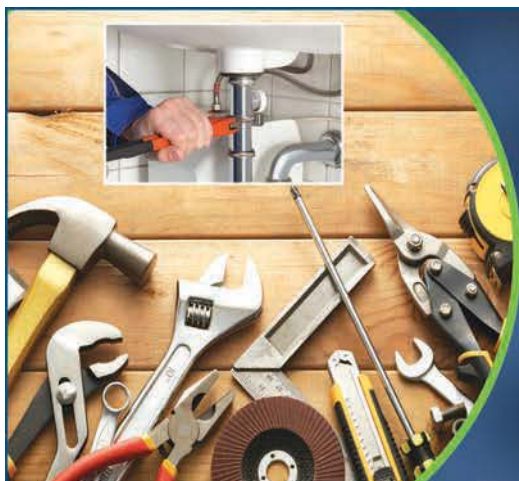
